If you have received flood damage to your home or business we are sincerely regretful. The St. Tammany Parish Assessor's Office currently has field crews on the ground surveying the damage. We are also working closely with parish government in these efforts to verify all flood data.

What you need to do:

- *Give either of our office locations a call.*

Let us know your home or business has flooded. We will verify the information and depreciate your assessment accordingly for 2016. You will be receiving a letter in the mail from the Assessor's Office in 4 – 6 weeks confirming this.

- *Check back with us in August when the tax roll is open for public inspection.*

At this time you will be able to view your assessment. You can do this online at www.stpao.org or just give us a call. It is important you verify your assessments in August. Do not wait until the tax bills go out in December.

What you do NOT need to do:

- *You do not need to come into our office.*

We know you have enough to do right now, considering what you have been through. A simple phone call suffices.

- *You do not need to fill out a review form or any other paperwork.*
- *You do not need to provide us with any cost or damage estimates.*

Homes & businesses that have been flooded will have their assessments reduced for 2016.
